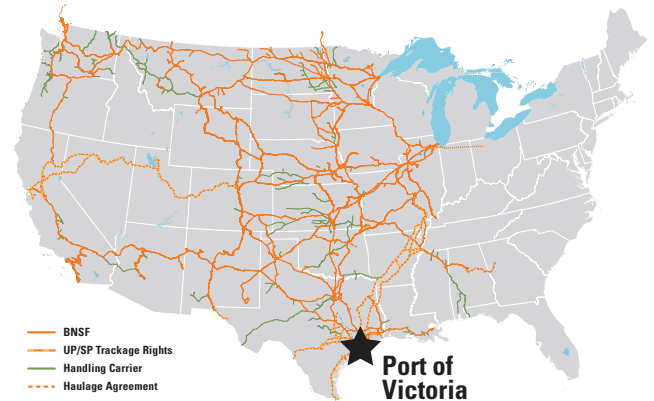


Port of Victoria

The Port of Victoria is located on the mid-coast of Texas strategically between Houston and Corpus Christi. The Port of Victoria is within a two hour drive of Houston, Austin, San Antonio, and Corpus Christi. Fifteen million Texas consumers are within a half a day's driving distance for a business looking to move products to markets. From the Port of Victoria, and the mid-coast of Texas, international and domestic cargo can be moved via the Victoria Barge Canal, Gulf Intracoastal Waterway system, Gulf of Mexico, inland waterways, four lane divided highways, and rail. The Port of Victoria is a gateway to domestic and international markets because of transportation options and its unique geographic location.
