

INTERMODAL LIFE CYCLE



1 Freight is loaded and unit leaves the dock



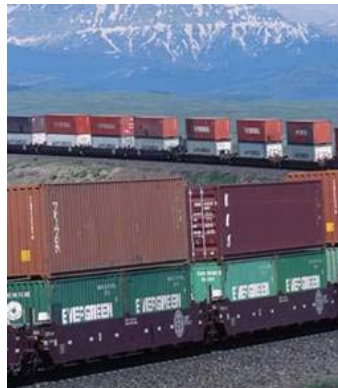
2 Your load arrives at a BNSF facility and the trailer or container number is scanned and shipping instructions are electronically confirmed



3 Your load is then inspected and sealed to ensure safe delivery



4 It is then loaded onto a railcar and sent on its way to its destination



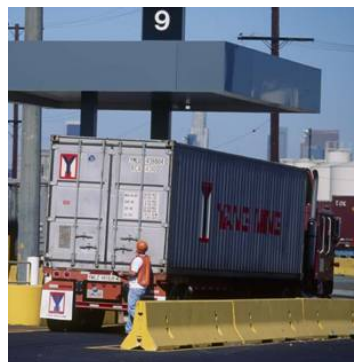
5 Your unit is traceable via the BNSF Web site every mile of the way. You are notified to arrange pick-up well before your shipment arrives.



6 At destination, your unit is lifted off the railcar



7 Your shipment will be at a designated spot in the intermodal yard awaiting pick-up



8 When your load leaves the Intermodal Hub, it is checked by BNSF to ensure the driver has picked up the correct unit. It is also inspected for any damage.



9 Your load arrives safely at the dock of your final shipping destination
