Mileage-Based Fuel Surcharge Expansion Effective April 25, 2007

As announced March 7, 2007, BNSF plans to extend its mileage-based fuel surcharge program effective April 25, 2007, to those shipments covered by the Surface Transportation Board (STB) fuel surcharge ruling of January 26, 2007.

BNSF's "All Other Carload" mileage-based fuel surcharge table will apply to public regulated, non-contract, non-boxcar shipments for which rates have not been prescribed by the STB. The table and the actual fuel surcharges for April 25-30, 2007, and the full month of May 2007 are available on the Web at <http://www.bnsf.com/tools/prices/fuelsurcharge/othercarload.html>.

Mileage calculations between stations on BNSF will be based on shortest-route BNSF mileage. Customers can compute mileage between BNSF-served points using the mileage inquiry on the Web at <http://www.bnsf.com/bnsf.was5/RailMiles/RMCentralController>.

Effective April 25, 2007, BNSF also will apply a mileage-based fuel surcharge to interline moves for which BNSF has pricing authority. Interline mileage will be the shortest non-familized interactive miles available in PC*Miler Rail from ALK Technologies.
