



Total units and % change from 2015














Ag Shuttle Fleet Productivity


BNSF COAL AVERAGE TRAIN SPEED






Intermodal Performance

BNSF INTERMODAL WEEKLY AVG. TRANSIT HOURS VS. ON-TIME PERFORMANCE




