The BNSF Police Department is a Class 1 Railroad law enforcement agency of BNSF Railway. BNSF is one of North America's leading freight transportation companies, with a rail network of 32,500 route miles in 28 states and three Canadian provinces.

BNSF Police is a dynamic, unique, and diverse police department which is comprised of members from across the United States. Each member of the team brings a tremendous amount of policing skills and knowledge. Members are fully sworn POST certified police officers and have been granted Federal Interstate Authority as defined in Title 49, USC section 28101. This authority allows each member of the police team to conduct law enforcement activities in states where the railroad operates. BNSF Police team consists of over 180 sworn agents and over 20 support personnel.





WHAT WE DO

Members of the police team conduct proactive patrols across the network and investigate crimes committed on railroad property. Special Agents may investigate the following:

- Illegal trespassing offenses
- Graffiti/vandalism to rail cars
- Theft of railroad property or customer product
- Train derailments
- Grade crossing accidents

BNSF Police team members partner with state and local agencies to help deter crimes conducted on railroad property or against railroad employees.
