The Port of Victoria is located on the mid-coast of Texas, strategically between Houston and Corpus Christi. The Port of Victoria is within a two-hour drive of Houston, Austin, San Antonio, and Corpus Christi. Fifteen million Texas consumers are within half a day's driving distance for a business looking to move products to markets. From the Port of Victoria and the mid-coast of Texas, international and domestic cargo can be moved via the Victoria Barge Canal, Gulf Intracoastal Waterway system, Gulf of Mexico, inland waterways, four-lane divided highways, and rail. The Port of Victoria is a gateway to domestic and international markets because of transportation options and its unique geographic location.
